

How to use this book:

- You need one person to be the Reader and at least one Apprentice.
- The Reader should be whoever is best at doing fun voices.
- The Reader can change the rules and add bonus points to make sure the Apprentice is having fun.
- Text in this font is just for the Reader.
- Text in the Adventurer's handwriting should be read aloud.
- The Apprentice will use their imagination, dice rolls and their problem solving skills to find a solution for each page.
- This game uses 1 six-sided dice to determine if the apprentice's ideas have worked. Rolling higher numbers is usually better.
- If their idea didn't work, they can think of a different idea and try again.

To begin, roll the dice to decide what 1 item is in the bag. This may change each time you read the book.

- 1 - Non slip shoes
- 2 - Rope ladder
- 3 - Bag of apples
- 4 - Shrinking potion
- 5 - A hand bell
- 6 - Invisibility cloak

"This is a map of the town where you live. The Magical Menagerie is a shop selling magical creatures and the things to take care of them.

Using the map, find the fastest way from your home to the Magical Menagerie. It's market day so some of the roads are blocked with people bringing things to sell. You might need to squeeze around or climb over the carts on the roads."

The Apprentice must draw a path, through the maze, with their finger. When they reach a cart , roll the dice to see if they can squeeze around or climb over the cart.

If the Apprentice uses their Rope Ladder: +2 to each roll.

Roll 1-3: The Apprentice couldn't get past. Find another route.

Roll 4-6: Success. Apprentice passes that cart and continues.

If the Apprentice took a longer route -

"I've aged 5 years in the time it took you to get here! I should let my Four-Clawed Vipers chase you down the street to get you in shape!"

If the Apprentice took a shorter route -

"Oi! What are you doing here already? Did you take a taxi? That's not how apprentices did it back in MY day!"

"Right, You. Take this egg to The Adventurer. You don't want it hatching before you get there. That would be a disaster for the whole town!"

Never mind what's inside the egg: that's none of your business. All you need to know is that it's ready to hatch TODAY!"
